

This risk assessment covers the bringing of animals to offsite locations for the purpose of entertainment and education by Jurassic Wildlife Adventures.

Risk Identified	Risk Level	Management of Risk
Bites/scratches/aggressive behaviour of animals	Low	<ul> <li>Presenter will assess the animals mood, feeding schedule and behaviour before approving them for a presentation</li> <li>Clients/general public will have no physical contact with any animals without the permission of the presenter and only under controlled circumstances</li> <li>Warnings and behaviour expectations will be explained prior to the presentation</li> <li>Set up of the room will be done so to avoid overcrowding and reduce animal stress</li> </ul>
Animal waste	High	<ul> <li>Cleaning products will be carried by the presenter and animals will be presented in or over pouches/containers</li> <li>Animals will be held at a reasonable distance from clients/public to minimise risk of their contact with animal waste</li> <li>F10 will be carried and offered to clients/public to clean hands afterwards hand washing will also be recommended after presentation</li> </ul>
Escapes	Low	<ul> <li>Presenter will begin the established escaped animal protocol</li> <li>When not being presented, all animals travel and remain in escape proof containers</li> <li>Expectation of clients is that they will listen to all instructions from the presenter</li> </ul>
Unpredictable animal behaviour	Low	<ul> <li>No food is to be brought into the presentation space, unless brought by the presenter</li> <li>Noise and movement is to be kept to a reasonable level to avoid scaring the</li> </ul>

		animals  If an animal becomes stressed, they will be removed from the area
Allergies	Low	<ul> <li>Presenter will check prior to commencing the presentation if there are any allergies</li> <li>Clients to wash hands after the presentation and F10 between any contact with animals</li> </ul>
Virus/Germ transmission	Low	<ul> <li>Presenter will assess the animals mood, feeding schedule and behaviour before approving them for a presentation</li> <li>Regular vet visits are conducted to ensure the animals are in good health</li> <li>Clients to wash hands after the presentation and F10 between any contact with animals</li> </ul>
Appropriate age activity	Low	<ul> <li>The presenter will assess the age group and determine the appropriate level of animal interaction according to that</li> <li>Handling of certain animals will be restricted where it is deemed inappropriate due to age/behaviour</li> </ul>
Animal transportation	Low	<ul> <li>Property owner/organiser to provide adequately close parking to reduce distance between the vehicle and presentation area</li> <li>Presenter will ensure safe unloading and loading of animals</li> <li>Animals to be transported in secure containers</li> </ul>

## Method Statement

We will endeavour to always

- 1. Travel safely to and from offsite locations taking breaks when necessary
- 2. Be punctual
- 3. Assess presentation area
- 4. Ensure animals are secured when not being presented
- 5. Any animals showing signs of tiredness or aggressive behaviour will be removed from the area as soon as possible
- 6. Only bring animals in good health and a good mood
- 7. Treat clients and general public with respect
- 8. Leave the area free of waste from animals or mess
